... **The Diocese of Tyler Catholic Charities** office distributed \$66,300 to 39 parishes for Hunger Relief efforts feeding 5,710 families in your community.

...The Diocese of Tyler Catholic Charities office distributed \$99,905 to 331 families affected by tornadoes in Alto and San Augustine TX.

...Catholic Charities serves all people within the 33 counties of the Diocese of Tyler.

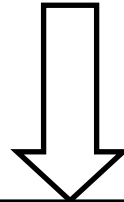
